- 01 You act safely and competently.
- 02 You give priority to students' safety and well-being in all your behaviour and decision making.
- 03 You act in accordance with the values of the Gospel as defined in the Code of Ethical Conduct.
- 04 You conduct yourself in accordance with laws, agreements, policies and standards relevant to your relationship with the school community.
- 05 You respect the dignity, culture, values and beliefs of each member of the school community.
- 06 You treat personal information about members of the school community as private and confidential.
- 07 You give impartial, honest and accurate information about the education, safety and well-being of students.
- 08 You support all members of the school community in making informed decisions about students.
- 09 You promote and preserve the trust and privilege inherent in your relationship with all members of the school community.
- 10 You maintain and build on the community's trust and confidence in Catholic schools and the Church.
- 11 You act reflectively and ethically.
- 12 You allow students to have a voice in their education, safety and well-being.

## PURPOSE

The purpose of the Code of Conduct is to describe minimum standards of conduct in all behaviour and decision making to ensure the safety and well-being of students.
