Capital Expenditure

- Lawn / Landscaping

Budget Expenditure / Financial Challenges

- Teachers 5% back paid to 6 Dec 2022 Oct 2023 paid in 2023
- Teachers \$3,000 one-off Enterprise Bargaining Agreement (EBA) payment paid in 2023
- EBA annual increase of 3% for relevant non-teaching staff
- Annual incremental teacher pay increase based on level of years' of experience
- Increase of Superannuation from 1 July
- 10% increase in insurance premiums
- Operating Leases increase of 6% due to the additional iPads for Year 3 in 2024
- Property Maintenance increase of 10.7% due to the maintenance of new lawn
- Stagnated school fees due to financial impact from the Covid pandemic

Highlights

- Increased enrolments Early Childhood Education (ECE) near or at capacity 91%
- Enrolment vacancies low
- Outside School Hours Care (OSCH) enrolments have increased exponentially which required applying to CEWA for extra licenced space to use within the school.
- Steady cash reserves
- Increased enrolments ie additional 3rd day commencing in 3 year-old kindergarten
